The IMCRE is an indigenous community's research manual guideline in the form of a bookle Mishmi Hills. It was finalised after more than five years after wide community consultatio Mishmis.

The community could be the first in the state to have its own community research guidelines

"The purpose of the IMCRE is to meaningfully and constructively engage with researchers without derogating from the foundational legal principles such as self-determination, free, pi non-discrimination, right to privacy, transparency, accountability, mutual cooperation and be The objective is to decolonise and decentralise research and encourage traditional knowledg informed the IMCLS.
